The AGM begins at 7pm, followed by the Reed Neet at 8pm. The Reed Neet is our tribute to Fred Reed, one of the founders of the Northumbrian Language Society, and our acclaimed Poet Laureate. After the Pipin In O The Stotty, we have our traditional Pie & Peas Supper. Guests then celebrate the event in toasts to the Bard and to the Stotty, followed by contributions from the audience.
