Welcome to the first ever online festival of traditional Northumbrian music, dance, craft, dialect, drama and heritage. Normally held the weekend after Easter in Northumberland's historic county town of Morpeth, the Gathering's programme was cancelled in 2020 for the first time since 1968, thanks to the pandemic – but we're now delighted to present a virtual festival to keep the flag flying in the spring of 2021.

Most events will be accessed via our YouTube channel unless stated otherwise. They will launch at the times given below, staying online over the weekend and in most cases into the future for people to catch up. Last-minute news or changes will be announced on Facebook.
